About the Mentorship Session

We're offering **virtual**, **one-hour webinar sessions** in December 2025 and January 2026, approximately 3–4 weeks before IMSH.

Each session will include up to **two presentations**, providing the chance to both receive feedback and observe your peers.

- You'll give a **brief presentation (up to 10 minutes)** to a small group of fellow presenters and three **SSH Fellows**.
- These Fellows, experienced leaders in healthcare simulation, will provide **personalized**, **constructive feedback**.
- Feedback will focus on content clarity, slide design, delivery & style, audience engagement, and organization.
- You'll also have the opportunity to **collaborate with peers**, share ideas, and learn from each other.
- The primary presenter is required to attend the session, and co-presenters are welcome to join as well.

What You Can Expect

- **Focused Guidance**: A 10-minute presentation followed by 10 minutes of individual feedback.
- Peer Learning: Watch others present and gain ideas for your own session.
- **Confidence Boost**: Rehearse in a supportive setting and gain insight to help you succeed at SimOps.
- Collaborative Experience: Connect with other presenters and seasoned SSH professionals.
