ADD-ON'S

Additional Table-Top Space - \$750

If your exhibit is going to take up greater than the allotted 2' x 5' space, you will be required to purchase an additional exhibit space. This will be strictly enforced. For example, if you have a simulator that will extend longer than a width of 5' then you will need to purchase additional space. If you have a VR set up that requires hands-on demonstration, you will need to purchase additional space. Your total exhibit space inclusive of additional purchased space cannot exceed 10' in width, and 4' in depth

NOTE – ALL EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING THEIR OWN EXTENSION CORDS. NOT ALL EXHIBIT SPACES WILL HAVE POWER DIRECTLY AT THEIR TABLE, SO AN EXTENSION CORD MAY BE REQUIRED. IF YOU DO NOT BRING AN EXTENSION CORD, YOU MAY NEED TO PURCHASE ONE WHEN YOU ARRIVE ON-SITE.

To ensure successful shipping of your instruments, equipment, and supplies to and from CAMLS, please follow the instructions below.

Shipping and Receiving Hours

- Monday – Friday from 8:00 am – 4:00 pm (Closed on USF Holidays)

Loading & Delivery Area

- **Delivery and pickup access are on the North side of the building located off of Florida Avenue or Franklin Street. Please make sure this information is provided to the delivery drivers.**
- All drivers should check in with security utilizing the intercom near the service door access.
- CAMLS has a loading and delivery area, but not a loading dock. Large equipment should be delivered on a truck with a lift to the ground.
- The inner dimensions of the delivery door are 63” wide x 82” tall. There is a “cuff” that holds the center post, which can be removed, if necessary, that will provide an additional 2” of height clearance.
- Please call the front desk, at 727-743-3280 or 813-224-7901, with any delivery or pickup questions/ issues.

Service Elevator Specifications (surgical/bioskills labs are located on the first floor so the service elevator will not be needed)

- The service elevator load capacity is 4,500 pounds.
- Service elevator dimensions are as follows: -
 - o Entrance opening: 4’
 - o Width: 5’4”
 - o Depth: 9’3”
 - o Height: 7’8”

Incoming Shipments to CAMLS

- Shipments may be received 3 business days prior to the program start date. For deliveries outside of this period, please obtain pre-approval from the CAMLS coordinator to avoid additional charges.
- Either the client or the designated shipping company is responsible for unloading freight trucks. The client is also responsible for unpacking all shipments and removing crates from the CAMLS facility (CAMLS does not have adequate space to store crates).

Outgoing Shipments from CAMLS

- Clients are responsible for packing, correctly labeling and scheduling pickups for all outgoing shipments preferably with a pickup on Monday – Friday from 8:00 am – 4:00 pm or when the client is still at the CAMLS building.
- The client or their designated shipping company must load freight trucks. CAMLS does not have shipping and handling staff.
- Shipments must be picked up within 3 business days of program completion. For pickups planned outside of this period, please obtain pre-approval from the CAMLS coordinator to avoid additional charges.

PAYMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Exhibit fees can be paid for by credit or debit card, check, or wire transfer. No payments will be accepted on site.
- If you choose to receive an invoice, it will be sent electronically only.

CANCELLATION AND/ OR REDUCTION OF SPACE

Cancellation of booth space, sponsorship, or requests for reduction of space must be made in writing. The following cancellation and/or reduction of space fees apply:

- Before April 15, 2026: \$250 administration fee
- April 15 – May 15, 2026: 50% of exhibits fees
- After May 15, 2026 – 100% of exhibits fees

SSH will not cancel hotel reservations. The registrant is responsible for notifying the hotel and cancelling their accommodations.

SimOps Terms & Conditions

SimOps (the "Conference") is presented by the Society for Simulation in Healthcare (SSH). By registering for the Conference you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.

Changes to the Agenda

- SSH reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to make changes to the SimOps Conference program. Every effort will be made to keep presentations and speakers as represented. However, unforeseen circumstances may result in the substitution of presentation topic(s) speaker(s), or event(s).
- In the event the Conference must be cancelled or changed, SSH is not liable to exhibitors for any damages, losses, costs, or other liability, including but not limited to transportation, visa application, or accommodation costs. SSH is not

liable to exhibitors for any costs, fees, expenses, damages, or other liability relating to changes to the Conference, including but not limited to date, content, speakers or venue.

Participation and Behavior

SimOps attendees are expected to behave professionally. Excessive use of obscene language, abusive behavior, or threatening behavior directed to any other Conference attendee, staff and SSH vendors is not conducive to a business environment and individuals exhibiting such behavior may be ejected from the Conference. There will be no refund of any portion of registration or exhibit fees paid.

Age Restrictions for the Exhibit Hall and Courses

Personal Property

SSH is not liable to any Attendee for loss or damage to personal property.

Refusal of Registration and/or Admission

SSH reserves the right and sole discretion to refuse admission to, or eject from the SimOps Conference, any person. You agree to comply with all reasonable instructions issued by SSH, the venue owners at the Conference, or their delegates.
